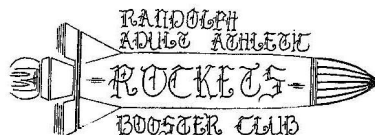

Rules of Play:

1. 3-man team and 1 sub 4-man roster -there will be no roster changes allowed after your first game.
2. Teams must be at their court at the scheduled time. A 5 minute forfeit time will be strictly enforced.
3. Before the game both teams may warm up for not more than 2 minutes.
4. A coin flip will determine the first possession of the ball.
5. We will have Adults monitoring each court.
6. Each court will have a check line. A player must pass the ball in from this line at the start of the game and after each made basket. (No make it take it.) On defensive rebounds or steals the ball must be returned to the check line and the player in possession of the ball may retain the ball and attempt to score.
7. All fouls will be checked up at the top of the key. There will be no free throw shots taken. If a player is fouled and makes the basket the basket is good and the possession goes to the other team.
8. 1st team to score 13 points is the winner. Each basket is worth 1 point. The three-point field goal will not be in effect!
9. There will be a 20-minute time limit placed on each game.
10. The clock will run continuously during the game.
11. Player substitution is permitted during any dead ball situation simply yell "sub."
12. If the game reaches the end of the 20-minute time period and neither team has won, then the team that is ahead is the winner. If the game reaches the time limit and score is tied the teams will play the sudden death playoff- 1st basket wins, with the team that lost the coin toss at the start of the game getting the possession of the ball first.
13. Stalling is not allowed at any time during the game. The monitors have the authority to impose a 30 second shot clock if she/he believes a team is stalling the ball. If a shot that draws iron is not attempted within 30 seconds after notification by monitor possession of the ball is forfeited.
14. Each team gets 1 60-second time out.
15. Player participates in this tournament at their own risk. The organizers are not responsible for any injury or loss, however caused.
16. Under no circumstances will the organizers of this tournament tolerate rough play and or abusive language. Players displaying this type of behavior may be dismissed from the game and or tournament without a refund of entry fee.
17. After a made basket, after a rebound, or dead ball player must take the ball to the top of the key with no pressure.
