The customer shall protect the water curb stop box located in the front lawn or sidewalk area and shall keep the same free from dirt and other obstructions. The water utility shall not be liable for failure to locate the curb stop box and shut off the water in case of a leak on the owner's premise. Also, **please do not flush hypodermic needles, feminine items, hygienic wipes, underwear or other foreign objects down the toilet.** These items can cause blockages in the sewer mains and some can result in personal injury to the operators at the Sewer Processing Plant. ~Never place unused medications or chemicals down the toilet or drain~
